Dear Parents & Carers,

Happy New Year and welcome back to the Spring term 2022. I hope that you have all enjoyed the festive period and remained well.

Covid Safety Measures

I would like to reassure all parents and carers that we will continue to do everything we can to keep the school and all of our pupils and staff safe during this term.

Our Covid Risk Assessments have been updated for Spring 2022; we are following all of the latest Government advice and guidance and our Outbreak Management Plan remains in place. Our school will remain open for all pupils who are fit and well.

The school building continues to be well ventilated, staff and children will continue to maintain good personal hygiene, with regular hand washing and the use of sanitiser and tissues. All staff now wear masks in communal areas, and some staff have chosen to wear their masks whilst teaching during this latest Covid peak.

With effect from Tuesday 11th January, the guidance has changed with regards to PCR testing. The guidance states:

Confirmatory PCR tests to be temporarily suspended for positive lateral flow device (LFD) test results
Confirmatory PCR tests following a positive lateral flow device (LFD) test result are to be temporarily suspended from Tuesday 11 January. This will mean that anyone who receives a positive LFD test result will be required to self-isolate immediately and will not be required to take a confirmatory PCR test.

Please do not send your child in to school if they are unwell until you are 100% sure that they do not have Covid. If your child does test positive for Covid, please inform the school. We will be able to offer daily online remote education for your child in this situation, if they are well enough to access it.
