Cricket Final

Woodbury's cricketers took part in the Devon Finals on yesterday and came up against the best school teams from all across the county. The team showed superb sportsmanship together with vast amounts of skill as they overcame their opponents in their 3 group matches and earned themselves a place in the final against Stoke Hill. It is fair to say that both Mr Norton and Mr Preston will have a few more grey hairs as the final went down to the last ball. Stoke Hill had restricted Woodbury to quite a modest total with some very accurate bowling and looked on course for victory. But Woodbury had other ideas. Equally good bowling and superb fielding from the whole team saw Stoke Hill still needing 3 runs from the last ball of the match. Woodbury held their nerve, denying Stoke Hill the runs they needed and in so doing were crowned Devon Champions.

The children were superb ambassadors for the school throughout the day and so huge congratulations to Wren, Eve, Max, Lucas, Nat, Ellis, Luis and their captain Jonah. Thank you to Mr Preston for running cricket club which has allowed the children the opportunity to develop their skills. Thank you also to Mr Norton for organising the event and to those parents who supported the children both in the qualifying round at the final.

Sports Days – Next week (weather permitting)

On **Monday it is KS1** sports day and on **Tuesday KS2**, both starting at **1.30pm**. Please ensure the children come dressed in their PE kit on the day of their Sports Day. Beech class children do not need to wear a school uniform PE kit if they do not yet have one but will need suitable footwear.

Our sports days operate on a rotational activity system, where the children work around a series of running jumping and throwing events throughout the afternoon. Parents and carers watch as they undertake these activities and move with the children to each activity. This year sports trophies **will not** be announced at the end of the afternoon but the next day to allow us to count the points. There will however be 2 awards announced for each class for children who have demonstrated sportsmanship, effort, or our school values during the afternoon.

Please can I remind you to park considerably when attending our sports day – there may be more cars than usual so please ensure you leave a little extra time and do not park in front of our neighbours' driveways or obstruct roads, so lorries or emergency vehicles struggle to get through.
