Vaccination Information

Since Tuesday 5 April, all children aged five and over are eligible to have the COVID-19 vaccination.

They will not be given to this age group inside of schools; however, NHS Devon Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG) are encouraging parents or carers to get their children vaccinated.

Having the COVID-19 vaccine reduces the likelihood of further disruption to education and reduces the risk of developing Long COVID.
